Farm and Ranch Program

Stable Rules:

- A. Hard-soled fully enclosed shoes and long pants will be required at all times.
- B. No extra feed or shavings without permission.
- C. No horse will be left unattended while tied, while loose in arena, or while grazing in public areas.
- D. Cars will be parked in designated areas only.
- E. Horses must be tied at designated areas only.
- F. No riding double for the sake of safety.
- G. Telephone will not be used without permission.
- H. Throwing trash anywhere in the stable will not be allowed (including shedding hair, etc.). Please use trash cans.
- I. Children less than six (6) years of age must be under constant supervision while at the stable.

The parent or guardian of any child will be responsible for their behavior at _____.

- J. Observe and obey all posted signs on premises, and check bulletin area weekly for important information.
- K. Other than resident stable dogs, all visiting dogs must be well-behaved or on a leash.
- L. No riding or turning horses loose in pasture without permission.
- M. No smoking in or near stalls, hay or shaving storage areas.
- N. Request for special services during regular working hours of ____am to ____pm **must** be made through _____ owner.
